


There should be a Find of the Month (from any category) for Youth.



"LUCK IS WHAT HAPPENS WHEN PREPARATION MEETS THE OPPORTUNITY.



Massachusetts and stopped at one house that looked promising. It had a plaque on it that dated 1798 and a large sized property. We pulled in and both went up to the door. The woman who opened the door was very pleasant and told us, "Sure you can detect, but please fill in all the holes that you dig." I assured her that we would and asked if anyone had lost anything over the years. If they had we would be glad to return it. She stated, to her knowledge, nothing had been lost. Right away I found a couple clad

Right away I found a couple clad coins, and then got a high sound on my CTX3030. It was a Barber dime down about 3 inches. I worked my way over to my friend to show him what I found. My friend showed me that he found a couple of Barber dimes, too. In the next hour I managed to find a Standing Liberty quarter that was almost unrecognizable and a couple more Mercury dimes along with the usual trash (nails, aluminum, pulltabs, and pieces of iron).

I decided I would move my detecting over to the side yard of the house in hopes of finding some older items, and boy did I. After about 20 minutes of detecting I got a solid high tone, which I



knew had to be silver. Not a foot away I uncovered a silver Rosie and a Wheat cent. After working the area back towards the house I got a solid tone and uncovered the oldest coin so far from the site: a 1902 Indian Head penny.

At the end of a trench I decided to work the sides. I started about two feet from the edge of the trench and found another Wheat cent. I worked the edge of the trench up about 50 feet and got a solid high, loud tone reading about 3 inches and thought I had just found my silver half dollar. Little did I know I had just found my oldest coin in 20 years of detecting. After digging a 4 inch plug, I could see that there was something silvery and it was BIG. When I pulled it out, I immediately saw the cross, noticed the coin wasn't completely round and that it also had a crack in it.

My first thought was I had just found an 8 reals, but figured it was fake because I couldn't be that lucky. After looking at it for a few minutes I started thinking that it really could be legitimate. When I got home I took a couple of pictures of it and sent them to a friend at the detecting club which I belong. He stated

Hey Quack, I was out with 2 of my friends in a very noisy field, and I managed to score this **1788 Massachusetts Colonial Copper**.
I also found a seated dime (1877) and a wheatie (1933). **300 years of coins found in 1 field.**





"On October 17, 1786, the Massachusetts General Court passed an act to establish a state-run mint to produce coins for circulation. The council established that the design of copper coins would incorporate the figure of an Indian with a bow and arrow, a star on one side, and the word "Commonwealth". The reverse was to have a spread eagle with words Massachusetts 1787.

The Massachusetts 1787 and 1788 cents and half cents were the first coins bearing the denomination cent and half-cent as established by Congress."

Subjects are really only limited to your imagination, as long as they involve digging or collecting. You might even consider a group effort among your club, or


ask individual members to write about a cool Find.




