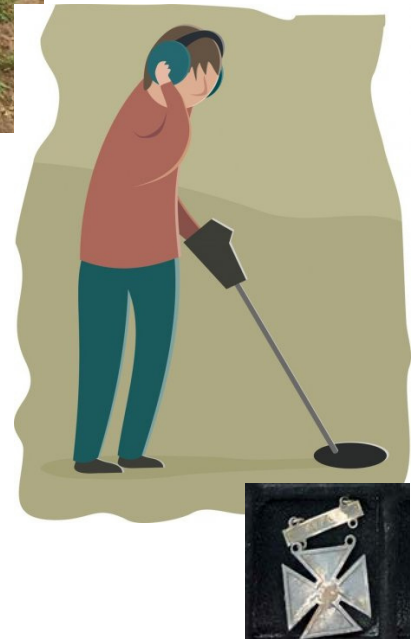

Unexpected Finds ...

"Hi Quack,

Almost forgot to email you.

Those copper/brass indian artifacts were found at 2 sites, one wooded and one hayfield that used to be a plowed field until 6 or 7 years ago.

Between the 2 sites my hunting buddy and I have probably found about 20+ points plus other artifacts including the rolled beads, what I think are probably leather awls, the fish hook and my buddy found a spoon all made from kettle brass.

Everything was found with either an XP Deus or Minelab Equinox 800 ... all at probably between 2 and 8 inches.

banning us from locations.

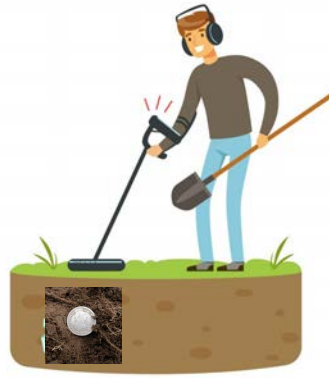
Land to detect will be harder to come by.

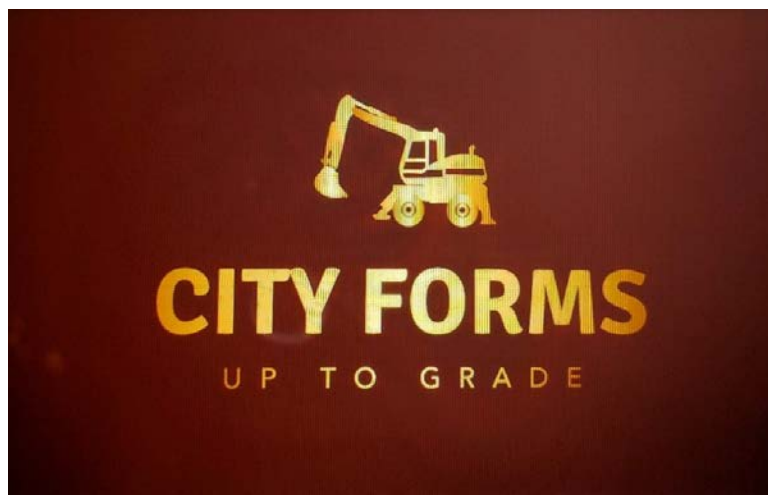

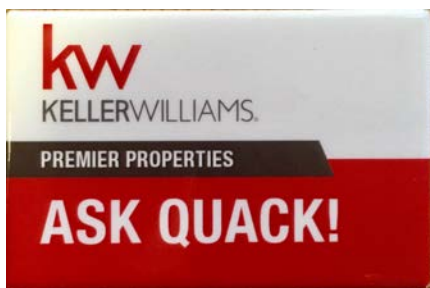
