

Crowds are gone ... but, the Tides still roll in ... and Out!





"Wet sand both class rings and a 14k wedding band were 6 - 8 feet from each other. The 2 small 10k rings were essentially the same hole, definitely from the same individual (pinky ring finger).

So far ... 16 total Gold rings, 1 Platinum and countless (20-25) Silver rings off this one beach this year.

First class ring belongs to a J. H. ... I've been in touch. Second class ring Sutton High ... belongs to a Cheryl ... haven't found her yet.

All found on the Cape with a **Minelab ctx3030**Always dig those Iffy targets, especially around rocky ironous areas ... both class rings and the 14k band sounded like total crap."






